

1. Important note:

You CANNOT configure the VPN client at your work location as you cannot VPN into your network if you are already inside it. If you are going to VPN in from home you need to configure it there.

2. You will need to download this software and install it per the following instructions.

Windows XP and Vista (32 Bit):

4. You now need to configure up your VPN Client using one of the following options.

(Most users will use option b.)

a. If you have received a configuration file via email use the following:

Automatic Setup (using config file):

Save the configuration file to your desktop.

Start the Global VPN Client (double click on the icon)

On the menu...

Click on: File;

Click on: Import Connection

Click on [...] and locate configuration file you saved to the desktop; select that file.

Encrypted password: *****

This should make a connection available in the SonicWALL Global GVC Client application.

Double click on the connection to connect the the VPN.

You can rename the connection in properties.
